## ANDREAS HOFER

German artist Hofer hopes that people looking at his work will take one thing from it: "time". However, considering he's currently working on a time tube, he may mean this more literally than we imagined. Hofer's work has confronted ideas of spatial and temporal continuity before: for

"Phantom Gallery" in 2008, he set up two gallery spaces, one in Zurich and another in LA, linked up by video conference, which were empty except for traces on the walls left by furniture. The video of the private view makes for enlightening viewing indeed.
